Observance of World Water Day 22nd March, 2023

In order to highlight the importance of safe drinking water and sanitation and make people aware about the issues related to both of these, Palampur Science Centre marked the day by organizing a set of activities, in this series a **popular** science lecture for the school students and general visitors was held. Followed by this an open house quiz was conducted, in which various question related to water, its physical and chemical properties, landforms and water holding areas, famous people and water conservation related questions were asked. After this programme a slogan writing contest was held in which students wrote their thoughts about water conservation and sanitation. The programme was concluded with distribution of bilingual e-certificates to the participants and prizes to the winners in the quiz.
